All Around Organic Compost

Compare the Difference:

<i>All Around Organic Compost</i>	<i>"Bio-Solid" Compost</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NOT!
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Derived from locally-sourced green waste from Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Derived from wet sludge (nitrogen source) and dry ground wood (carbon source)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully composted to provide consistency in nutrient levels and aroma, then screened for uniform size. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Components are turned over while infusing with air, keeping the material dryer. This allows testing to meet minimum EPA standards NOT fully composted.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safe to plant garden food crops in – no detectable levels of fecal coli or salmonella. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sludge may introduce fecal coli, salmonella, and other bacteria. Heavy metal content is regulated.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will not burn plants – All Around Organic Compost is stable when sold, and will not re-activate and heat-up when water is added. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Less stable – may re-activate with water, producing foul aromas, increased levels of fecal coli and other bacteria, as well as heat that can damage or kill plants.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consistent Neutral pH and C/N ratio provides a good balance of Organic matter and Ash. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inconsistent pH and ratios.

All Around Organic Compost is produced locally from local green-waste, for a lower carbon-footprint than compost trucked in from out of the region.
