**AZOMITE®** is an OMRI-listed, certified organic product used to re-mineralize soils that have been depleted by plant uptake and normal water erosion. It also provides a natural high quality calcium source to combat soil acidity or "sweeten" the soil, & create an environment where minerals are more available to the plants.

**AZOMITE®** is *not* a manufactured, chemically prepared fertilizer. *It is 100% natural with no additives, synthetics or filters.* It is a naturally occurring mineral product mined from the site of an ancient volcano in central Utah. The trade name **AZOMITE®** is an acronym for "**A to Z of Minerals Including Trace Elements**." It requires no mixing, is odorless, won't burn plants and won't restrict aeration or water penetration. The blend is granulated for easy spreading, and comes palletized in 40 lb. bags.

Chemically, **AZOMITE®** is a hydrated sodium calcium aluminosilicate (HSCAS) containing other minerals and trace elements which the National Research Council recognizes to be essential, including: Nitrogen, Phosphorous pentoxide, Potassium oxide, Calcium oxide, Ferric oxide, Magnesium oxide, Manganese oxide, Silica oxide, Sodium oxide, and Sulfur trioxide.
